**DECISIÓN DEL COMITÉ EJECUTIVO DE UEFA RELATIVA A UNA
MODIFICACIÓN DEL REGLAMENTO DE COMPETICIONES DE
CLUBES DE LA UEFA PARA LA TEMPORADA 2025/26.**

(Circular N.º 54/2024)

Por medio de la presente, la RFEF comunica a todos sus afiliados el contenido de la Circular N.º 54/2024 de UEFA.

Como podrán apreciar, a través de la misma UEFA informa sobre la modificación operada en el artículo 5.01 del Reglamento de Competiciones de clubes, que entrará en vigor en la temporada 2025/26.

En resumen, mediante la modificación aprobada:

- Se indica que el cambio realizado se refiere a la fecha de evaluación de los criterios de propiedad multiclub, y en concreto, el momento en el que los clubes deben cumplir con las normas contra la propiedad.
- Igualmente, en aras de proteger la integridad deportiva de las competiciones de la UEFA, el artículo 5 del Reglamento de Competiciones de clubes contiene disposiciones concretas que impiden que una parte controle o pueda ejercer una influencia decisiva en la toma de decisiones de más de un club que participe en la misma competición de clubes organizada por la UEFA.
- La enmienda aprobada por el Comité Ejecutivo de la UEFA adelanta la fecha de valoración al 1 de marzo para todas las competiciones de clubes, como consecuencia de la complejidad de los casos investigados por el Órgano de Control Financiero de Clubes. De esta forma, se pretende disponer de tiempo suficiente para completar el proceso de toma de decisiones que permita garantizar el buen funcionamiento de las competiciones de clubes de la UEFA.

- Por otra parte, la nueva fecha de evaluación será incluida en el Reglamento de Competiciones de clubes de la UEFA de la temporada 2025/26, que se someterá a aprobación en su totalidad en una fecha ulterior.
- De esta forma, el cambio aprobado otorga tiempo suficiente a los clubes para el cumplimiento de los criterios de propiedad multiclub estipulados en el artículo 5.01, con anterioridad a la citada nueva fecha límite para la temporada 2025/26.

Por ello, siendo responsabilidad de todos los colectivos afectados el conocimiento y cumplimiento de la referida normativa, sírvanse encontrar adjunto el texto íntegro de la Circular a los efectos oportunos.

En caso de cualquier consulta al respecto, les rogamos que se pongan en contacto con la Asesoría Jurídica de la RFEF a través de los medios habituales, cuyos miembros se encuentran a disposición de los estamentos del fútbol español para resolver aquellas dudas que dicha novedad pudiera generar.

Lo que se comunica a los efectos oportunos.

Decision of the UEFA Executive Committee regarding an amendment to the UEFA club competition regulations for the 2025/26 season

Dear Sir or Madam,

The UEFA Executive Committee has approved a change to Article 5.01 of the UEFA club competition regulations that will come into effect in the 2025/26 season. This change concerns the assessment date for multi-club ownership criteria, i.e. the deadline by which clubs must comply with the rules against multi-club ownership. The new assessment date will be included in the 2025/26 UEFA club competition regulations that will be submitted for approval in full at a later date.

It is of fundamental importance that the sporting integrity of UEFA club competitions be protected and that their perceived sporting integrity be undisputable. To that end, Article 5 of the club competition regulations contains specific provisions preventing one party from controlling or being able to exercise a decisive influence in the decision-making of more than one club participating in the same UEFA club competition.

For the 2024/25 season, the assessment date was 3 June 2024 for the men's club competitions and 1 July 2024 for the women's club competitions.

The amendment approved by the UEFA Executive Committee **brings the assessment date forward to 1 March for all club competitions**. This change was deemed necessary considering the complexity of the cases investigated by the Club Financial Control Body (CFCB), which is charged with dealing with multi-club ownership issues. The newly approved assessment date is intended to provide sufficient time for completion of the decision-making process and ensure the smooth running of UEFA's club competitions.

The change has been approved and communicated early to enable clubs to prepare and ensure their compliance with the multi-club ownership criteria stipulated in Article 5.01 ahead of the new deadline for the 2025/26 season.

Article 5.01 of the 2025/26 regulations of the UEFA Champions League, UEFA Europa League, UEFA Conference League and UEFA Women's Champions League will now read as follows (amended clause indicated in bold):

5.01 *To ensure the integrity of the UEFA club competitions, the club **must prove that as at 1 March preceding the competition season the below multi-club ownership criteria were met and the club must continue to comply with the below criteria from such date until the end of the competition season:***

- a. *No club participating in a UEFA club competition may, either directly or indirectly:*
 - i. *hold or deal in the securities or shares of any other club participating in a UEFA club competition;*
 - ii. *be a member of any other club participating in a UEFA club competition;*
 - iii. *be involved in any capacity whatsoever in the management, administration and/or sporting performance of any other club participating in a UEFA club competition; or*
 - iv. *have any power whatsoever in the management, administration and/or sporting performance of any other club participating in a UEFA club competition.*
- b. *No one may simultaneously be involved, either directly or indirectly, in any capacity whatsoever in the management, administration and/or sporting performance of more than one club participating in a UEFA club competition.*
- c. *No individual or legal entity may have control or influence over more than one club participating in a UEFA club competition, such control or influence being defined in this context as:*
 - i. *holding a majority of the shareholders' voting rights;*
 - ii. *having the right to appoint or remove a majority of the members of the administrative, management or supervisory body of the club;*
 - iii. *being a shareholder and alone controlling a majority of the shareholders' voting rights pursuant to an agreement entered into with other shareholders of the club; or*
 - iv. *being able to exercise by any means a decisive influence in the decision-making of the club.*
